A NOTE

THE Pastel medium has a distinguished record covering nearly three centuries: it has been used by a succession of famous artists whose work is available for reference, which proves how important pastel is as a means of artistic expression.

In explanation of its character and qualities, to make clear what is its nature, it is right to point out that pastel is not a medium with narrow limitations, suitable only for slight notes or hasty sketches. On the contrary, it is exceptionally flexible and adaptable to the widest possible range of treatment, from the merest suggestion to the detailed and carefully completed picture.

Pastel is of remarkable reliability. It neither fades, darkens, nor cracks, and only requires for its permanent preservation the ordinary care given to every work of art. Pastel always retains its freshness.

Of all the various materials at the disposal of an artist, it is the most straightforward in its use, enabling him to attain the greatest purity and beauty of colour.

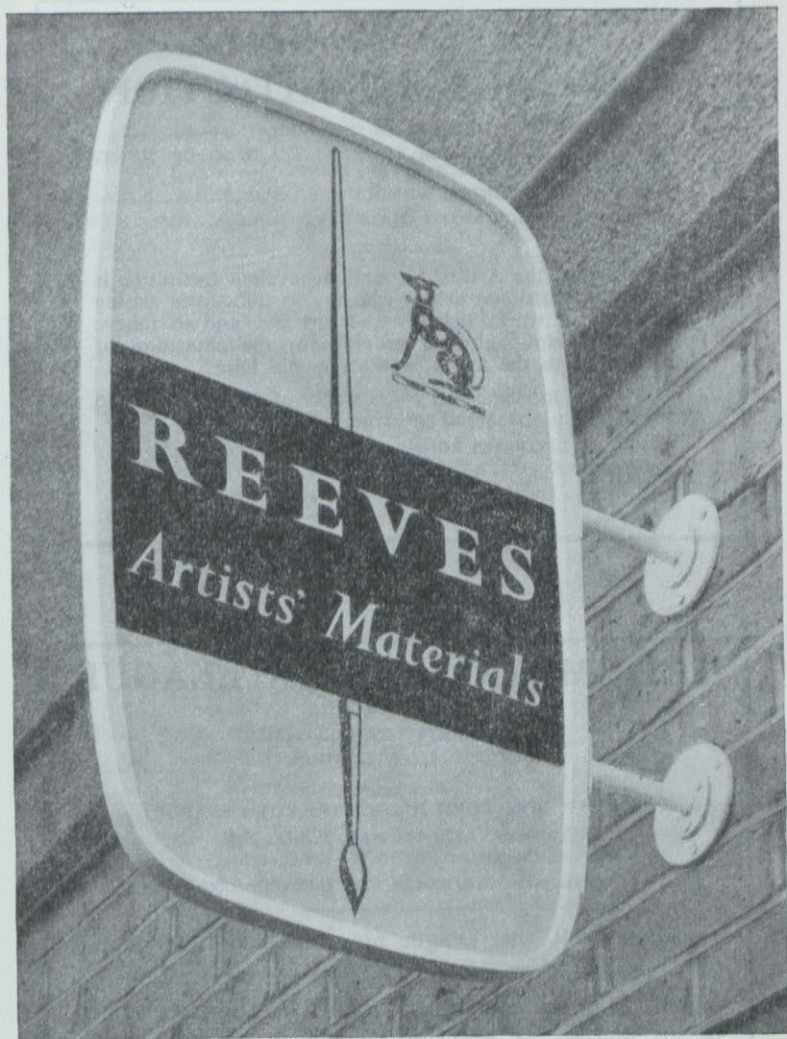
